Teesside Offshore Wind Farm is located approximately 1.5km offshore, between the mouth of the River Tees and up to 3km north-northwest of Redcar.

The project will consist of up to 30 wind turbine generators, rated between 2.0-3.6MW and associated infrastructure and will have a maximum installed capacity of 100MW.

PMSS were commissioned by EDF Energy in early 2007 to provide CDM Coordination services for the offshore Site Investigation campaigns including EOD surveys and geotechnical investigation.

Additional services provided to date include review of Jack-up and other vessels, tabulation of improvement plans, review of methodology and Risk Assessment, competence & resource assessments of proposed contractors and onsite inspections and auditing
